<p><b>That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the following capital release requests of £15k from the Disabled Facilities Grant (DFG) 2020/21 budget for the funding of grants for HIS and Able2 Occupational Therapy Assessments (Appendix A of the associated report).</b></p> <p><b>REASONS FOR THE DECISIONS MADE</b></p> <p>Disabled Facilities Grant funding will enable the adaptation of properties for elderly and disabled residents who require urgent assistance.
