<p>1.</p>	<p><i>THE CABINET MEMBER FOR FINANCE AND THE CABINET MEMBER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TRANSPORT</i></p> <p><i>CAPITAL RELEASE REPORT (January 2021)</i> <i>DEPARTMENT: Residents Services</i> <i>SERVICE AREA/ PROGRAMME: High Speed 2 (HS2) Local Road Safety Fund</i> <i>RELEASE NO: 3</i></p> <p>DECISION: <u>FULL APPROVAL</u></p> <p>That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport approved the following capital release request of £21k from the High Speed 2 Road Safety Fund (Appendix A of the associated report).</p> <p>Reasons for recommendations</p> <p><u>Copthall Road East Crossing upgrade</u></p> <p>The scheme meets the objectives of the road safety fund as it will mitigate the impact of HS2 construction traffic. Swakeleys Road is a key local 'B' road in this area of the Borough and, whilst not an official HS2 construction, traffic suffers from traffic displacement associated with HS2 traffic, closures and other interruptions.</p> <p>The provision of this upgrade to the existing formal crossing will provide a lasting legacy for road safety in the area, as even without construction traffic Swakeleys Road is a highly trafficked route that needs to be crossed to allow residential areas to access local amenities, in particular local primary and secondary schools.</p> <p><u>Breakspear Road South/ Tile Kiln Lane Road safety improvements</u></p> <p>The scheme meets the objectives of the road safety fund as it will mitigate the impact of HS2 construction traffic. Breakspear Road South is a key route for HS2 construction traffic and provides access to one of the major HS2 construction sites in the Borough.</p> <p>The road has seen a significant increase in HGV traffic and other traffic associated with those working at this HS2 site.</p> <p>Alternative options considered</p> <p>The Cabinet Members may agree to not to proceed with the programme of works as outlined in the report or suggest alternative projects to which</p>	<p><i>Perry Scott, Director of Infrastructure, Procurement, Business Improvement, Communications, Waste Services and ICT</i></p> <p><i>Sophie Wilmot, Residents Services</i></p>
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	<p>funds could be allocated within the terms of the grant conditions.
