THE LEADER OF THE COUNCIL, THE CABINET MEMBER FOR FINANCE AND THE CABINET MEMBER FOR ENVIRONMENT, HOUSING AND REGENERATION</p> <p>NEW ALLOCATION OF S106 CONTRIBUTIONS & CAPITAL RELEASE 2021/22: LAKE FARM COUNTRY PARK FOOTPATH IMPROVEMENTS & MANAGEMENT OF FRAYS ISLAND LOCAL NATURE RESERVE. (RELEASE NO 6)</p> <p>DECISION: <u>FULL APPROVAL</u></p> <p>That the Leader of the Council and Cabinet Member for Finance:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Approved the allocation of £80,382 from the S106 contribution held by the Council at E/140/434B to be used towards footpath improvements and at Lake Farm Country Park; and2) Approved the allocation of £25,657 from the S106 contribution held by the Council at E/02/18 to be used towards footbridge maintenance works at Frays Island Nature Reserve. <p>That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Environment, Housing and Regeneration:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">3) Approved the capital release requesting £80,382 towards the schemes as outlined in Appendix A to the report. <p>REASONS FOR THE DECISIONS MADE</p> <p>The allocation of Section 106 (S106) and Section 278 (S278) funds is required to be formally approved by the Leader of the Council and the Cabinet Member for Finance on a case-by-case basis. The report requests the approval for the S106 funds held at the case reference detailed in the report to be committed, as outlined in the report.</p> <p>ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND REJECTED</p> <p>The Cabinet Members may agree to fund the scheme and/ or suggest alternative projects to which funds could be allocated within the terms of the relevant legal agreements.
