DECISION	APPROVED That the Cabinet Member for Finance, and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure, agree to the following capital release request of £35k from the Fire Safety workstream within the Housing Revenue Account Works to Stock Programme 2021/22 capital budget for the funding of the Installation of LED Communal Lighting System at Whitehall Road.
Reason for decision	<p>Fire risk assessments have identified that the Council does not comply with the mandatory requirement to provide emergency lighting in communal areas of residential low and medium rise blocks. Whitehall Road has been identified as a site that is deemed to require emergency lighting.</p> <p>In addition, the Electrical Installation Condition Report confirmed significant defects on the electrical installation and, in order to ensure the electrical installations are in a satisfactory condition to ensure compliance with BS7671, a complete upgrade of the system is recommended.</p>
