| | Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport agree: 1) Approve the appointment of CWG Group Ltd as principal contractor to undertake roofing works at Frithwood Primary School at a cost of £503k. 2) Agree to the capital release request of £595k from the 2022/23 School Conditions Building Programme budget for the funding of major roof repairs at Frithwood Primary School. |
| Reason for decision | Corrosive damage to corrugated roofs at the school are resulting in increasing leaks, the roof requires corrosion treatment and a liquid overlay to protect its long-term use. Fibre glass roofs on site are at the end of their serviceable life and two flat roofs on site need urgent attention, to undertake all works at the same time would be the most beneficial long-term solution. |
| Alternative options considered and rejected | Local repairs were considered but the corrosive damage is deemed too extensive to undertake temporary repairs. |
