	<b>Approved</b>  <b>That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport:</b>  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Accepted the tender of £363k from PFL Electrical Services Ltd for the installation of LED communal and emergency lighting to Cedars Car Park; and,</li><li>2. Agreed to the capital release request for £417k from the Property Works Programme capital budget 2022/23 for the installation of Commulite LED Intelligent 24v Communal Emergency Lighting System to reduce the Council's Carbon Footprint and Energy Consumption at Cedars Car Park.</li></ol>
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The existing lighting in Cedars Car Park, a Council owned car park was a significant energy demand with an associated high carbon footprint. In accordance with the objectives of the Council's Strategic Climate Action Plan, the park has been identified as having scope for improvement to operational requirements to reduce energy demands and the associated carbon footprint.
