### Decision made

<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor Jonathan Bianco – Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport
<b>Decision</b>	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport agreed the terms for the renewal of a lease negotiated by officers as detailed in this report and authorised Legal Services to complete the new lease on these terms.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The Cabinet Member is being asked to agree the proposed lease renewal in accordance with the Council's constitution. This requires the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport to formally authorise the grant of a lease of under 7 years at a rent of between £10k - £100k.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	The Cabinet Member could choose not to approve the lease renewal negotiated. This is likely to then require the lease renewal to be determined by an application to Court as the lease is within the security of tenure provisions under the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954, sections 24 – 28 and therefore, the tenant has an automatic right to renew.
