<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor Jonathan Bianco – Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport
<b>Decision</b>	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport:  Considered the objections received from the statutory consultation for the proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions on Hoylake Gardens, Eastcote.  Did not approve the introduction of the proposed 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions on Hoylake Gardens, Eastcote, as shown at Appendix B at the present time but agreed to keep the matter under review.
