Declares that 64-66 Byron Way, West Drayton, Middlesex, UB7 9JD is surplus to requirements, the Property is shown edged red on plan A.2. Declares that 28/28a & 29/29a High Road, Cowley, Middlesex, UB8 2HL are surplus to requirements, the Property is shown edged red on plan B.3. Declares that 2a-2b High Street, Ruislip HA4 7AR is surplus to requirements, the Property is shown edged red on plan C.4. Authorises the sale of the above freehold interests on the open market, the method of sale to be by private treaty, subject to prevailing market conditions.5. Authorises officers to make further decisions in respect of implementing these decisions, in conjunction with the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport.
