Decision	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation and the Cabinet Member for Planning, Housing & Growth agree to the capital release request of £400k from the Highways Bridges & Structures 2025/26 budget to support the schemes outlined in this report (Appendix A).
Reason for decision	The recommendation enables the release of funds to progress the Highways Structures Programme. The projects listed will limit the deterioration and preserve the structural integrity of the highway structures avoiding any undue failure of the structural elements. The works will improve the condition of the structures and the highway network. These works will be undertaken by the Council's Highways Term Service Contractor, O'Hara Bros Surfacing Ltd.
