| Decision | Approved The Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation, in conjunction with the Cabinet Member for Corporate Services & Property: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Approved the award of contract for the next phase of the Council's Roofing Programme, to be delivered over a 20-week period at a contract value of £203k; and• Agreed to allocate £233k (inclusive of contingencies and fees) from the Roof Renewals work-stream within the Housing Revenue Account Works to Stock programme 2025/26. |
| Reason for decision | The proposed contract is part of the Council's ongoing Roofing Programme, which ensures that homes are maintained to a good standard. This phase will focus on replacing roofs that have reached the end of their useful life, improving the condition of housing stock and providing long-term benefits for residents. The phased approach enables the Council to manage works efficiently, deliver projects in smaller packages, and achieve value for money through the use of specialist contractors. |

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| Alternative options considered and rejected | Moving away from the larger type of delivery contracts gives greater flexibility to deal with risks associated with poor contractor performance. This approach will enable more specialist contractors to deliver installations at lower costs. |
