Reason for decision	The recommendation is made to ensure that the vacancy for a Local Authority Governor is filled in line with statutory requirements. The LA School Governance Team has confirmed that the candidate has submitted all the necessary documentation, and the school has agreed to the nomination, allowing the process to move forward for approval. Appointing the candidate will not only meet the legal duty but will also strengthen the governing body, providing valuable support and oversight to the school's leadership. This appointment will help ensure that the governing body remains fully effective in its role of promoting high standards and accountability. In doing so, it reinforces the partnership between the Local Authority and the school community.
