Noted the application for a disabled parking bay in Wood Rise, Eastcote;</li><li>2. Considered the objections to the proposed disabled persons' parking bay on Wood Rise, Eastcote; and</li><li>3. Did not approve the installation of the proposed disabled persons' parking bay on Wood Rise, Eastcote.</li></ol>
