That the Cabinet Member for Finance and Transformation, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Health and Social Care (subject to written confirmation from NHS Property Services) approve the capital release (Appendix A) and transfer of the funds held at H/69/404F and H/61/382F to NWL ICB to be spent within the terms of the Service Level Agreement (SLA) dated 26 June 2015
