Decision	Agreed The Cabinet Member for Planning, Housing & Economic Growth: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Noted the significant number of respondents to the informal consultation;2. Considered all the responses for and against the proposals, as summarised in the report;3. Considered the issues raised by the consultation and how these might impact the effective operation of a school street;4. Decided not to progress with the school street restriction at that time, due to the number and impact of the issues raised; and5. Instructed officers to explore mitigation measures for the issues raised and report back.
Reason for decision	The recommendations set out in this report enable the Cabinet Member to understand the results of the consultation and the issues raised by residents and school users. Addressing and mitigating these issues will support future improvements to safety and ensure that any potential school street scheme can operate more effectively.
