Cabinet Members making the decision	Councillor Eddie Lavery, Cabinet Member for Finance and Transformation
Decision	Agreed That the Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation approves the allocation of £349,755.88 from the S106 contribution held at EYL/254/557C to be used towards works associated with the expansion at Meadow High School, Royal Lane, Hillingdon.
Reason for decision	In accordance with the Council's Constitution, the allocation of S106 funds was required to be formally approved by the Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation on a case-by-case basis, with any capital release approved alongside the relevant portfolio holder. Approval was requested for the S106 funds held under the case reference in the report to be committed as outlined.
Alternative options considered and rejected	The Cabinet Member considered and rejected alternative options, noting that while the scheme could have been funded or other eligible projects suggested, any S106 funds not allocated to an appropriate scheme would have needed to be refunded.
