Decision	Agreed The Cabinet Member agreed to the Instrument of Government for Whitehall School
Reason for decision	<p>Cabinet approved the decision on 23 April 2026 for the Amalgamation of Whitehall Infant School and Whitehall Junior School. Closing (technically) Whitehall Infant School and all pupils, staff, land, buildings and equipment would become part of Whitehall Junior School (which would become a Primary school) from 1st September 2026.</p> <p>Extending the age range of Whitehall Junior School from Years 3 to 6, to Nursery to Year 6 (and changing its name with effect from 1st September 2026</p> <p>The new primary school would continue to offer nursery provision, and therefore the age range would be from 3 to 11 year-olds, and would include existing pupils from the Infant and Junior schools.</p>
Alternative options considered and rejected	The Cabinet Member could decline to approve the creation of this new IoG or request more information about it.
